

We loan equipment at no cost to those who need it. You may use the equipment as long as you need, but we appreciate it if you return it back to us when you no longer need it.

We also accept donations of new and used medical equipment in good working condition. Your donation to Josie's Closet is tax-deductible through the Goessel Ministerial Alliance. All donated equipment is inspected and sanitized prior to use.

Types of Equipment We Accept and Loan:

- Bed-assist rails
- Shower chairs
- Commodes
- Stool risers
- Folding and wheeled walkers
- Wheelchairs and transport chairs
- Canes, including quad-based canes
- Knee walkers
- Crutches

 We also accept donations of adult disposable briefs and nutritional supplement shakes. We aren't able to accept all types of equipment, so please call if you have questions about a piece of medical equipment you would like to donate.
