*I like the OWL site because of the fish.

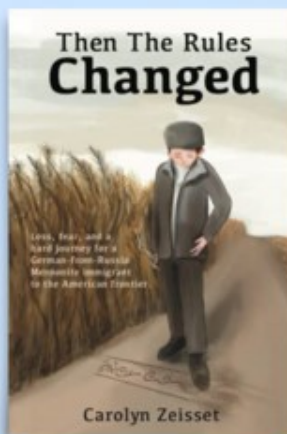
*I like the fish pond because there are goldfish.

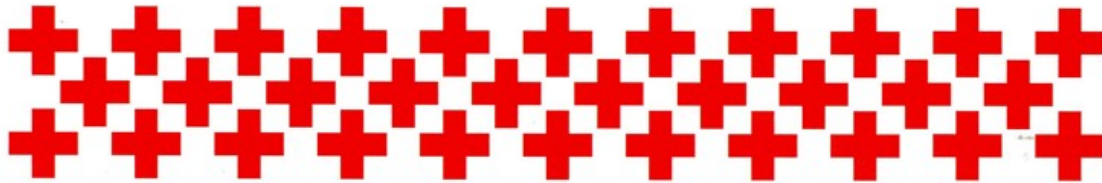
