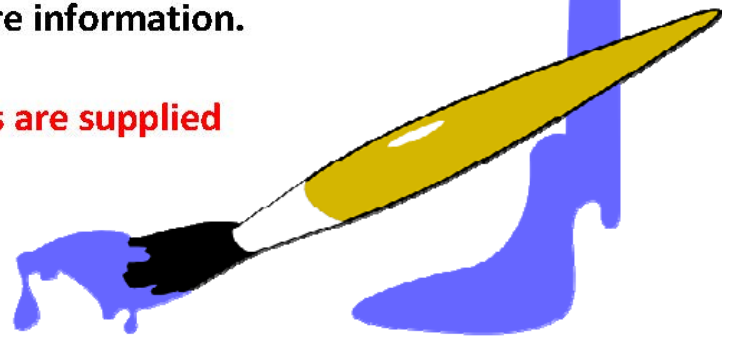

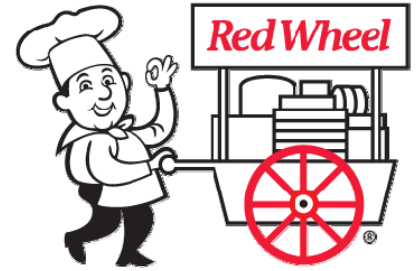
Goessel Elementary students will be taking orders for
