GOESSEL COMMUNITY FOUNDATION CONTRIBUTES TO THE BETHESDA FRIENDSHIP MEAL PROGRAM

Bethesda Home was a recent recipient of a \$1,020 distribution from the Goessel Community Seniors Endowed Fund that will go toward the support of the Bethesda Friendship Meal Program that provides an average of approximately 150 meals per month to community residents with limitations. These Friendship meals are then delivered at noon, Monday thru Friday, to their homes by a cadre of approximately 14 volunteers.

The distribution received from the Community Foundation pays for approximately 35% of the total annual cost to provide this service. The balance is covered by other donations to Bethesda Home and a nominal fee for the meals delivered to each recipient.

The Goessel Community Seniors Endowed Fund was established with funds from the sale of the AGAPE Sr. Center building with the annual earnings to be distributed to provide meals to area Sr. Citizens with at least one well balanced meal per day. The program is currently provided by the Bethesda Friendship Meal Program. 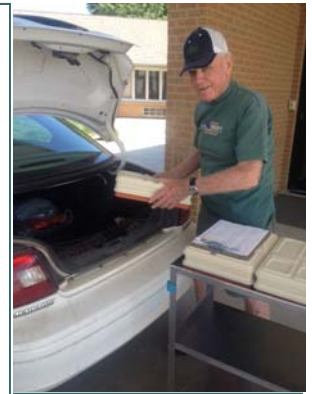
