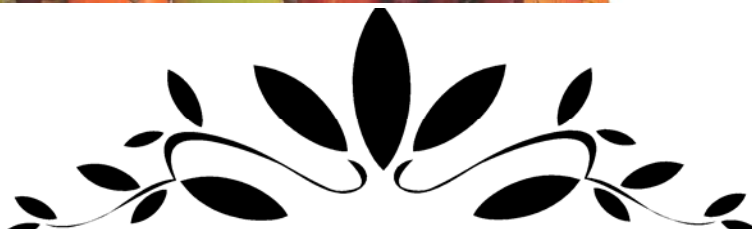

FOAM METER INSULATORS

As the cooler temperatures set in, it's time to start thinking about the cold winter months and preparing your water meters for freezing temperatures. Most of the water meters in town are in pits where the lids are level with the ground or even slightly below the ground level. If your meter pit is like this, then chances are it will not freeze unless we have prolonged extremely cold temperatures. If your meter lid is slightly above the ground, then it is susceptible to freezing especially when the wind is blowing. To prevent meters from freezing and the homeowner the expense of replacing the meter, the City has ordered some foam meter insulators that you can purchase from the City for \$10. 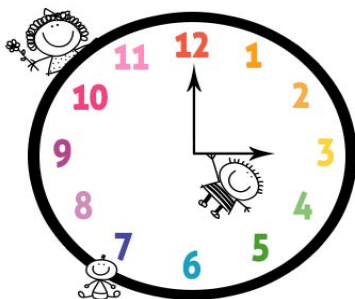

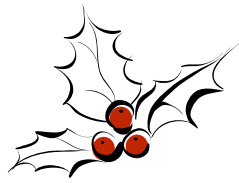
