We also accept donations of new and used medical equipment in good working condition. Your donation to Josie's Closet is tax-deductible through the Goessel Ministerial Alliance. All donated equipment is inspected and sanitized prior to use.

Types of Equipment We Accept and Loan:

- Bed-assist rails
- Shower chairs
- Commodes
- Stool risers
- Folding and wheeled walkers
- Wheelchairs and transport chairs
- Canes, including quad-based canes
- Knee walkers
- Crutches

- We also accept donations of adult disposable briefs and nutritional supplement shakes. We aren't able to accept all types of equipment, so please call if you have questions about a piece of medical equipment you would like to donate.

-The borrower is asked to sign an agreement to return the loaned items when they are no longer needed, so that we may pay it forward.

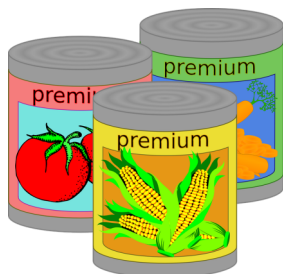
