Jonas: The Life and Times of an Amish Man

Early in 1995, Maynard Knepp and Carol Duerksen were working on an Amish novel based on Maynard's experiences growing up Amish. *Runaway Buggy* was published that fall and became a runaway success. This year, in celebration of the 20th anniversary of *Runaway Buggy*, the husband/wife team is putting "Jonas: The Life and Times of an Amish Man" on stage. Starring Maynard as Jonas Bontrager, the show is the fictional story of the elder Jonas, recalling the highlights of his life, and is based loosely on *Runaway Buggy* and the Amish novels that followed it.

The premier showing of "Jonas" will be March 8 at 7:00 p.m. at the Goessel High School Auditorium. Admission is \$5, with children under 12 free. Following "Jonas" there will be a book signing with Carol Duerksen and Sharon Hubbard and their new Amish novel, *Kate's Truth*.

All items purchased will be available for pick up on Tuesday, March 31 from 3:15-5:30 pm in the grade school cafeteria.




