## Dog Licenses Due

Per Goessel City Code, dog license renewals are due July 1st of each year for all dogs within the city limits. After July 31st, a 50% penalty will be added.

Please contact the city office to renew or purchase a new license for your dog(s). There is a **limit of 2** dogs per residence. If you have been granted permission in the past to have 3 dogs and one of the dogs dies or you get rid of one of the dogs, you cannot replace it with another dog. The **2 dog limit** is going to be strictly enforced. You can drop off your rabies



vaccination certificate along with the money for the tags

and we will mail the tag out to you. Cost of license:

Spayed or Neutered—\$4, Male—\$7, Female—\$12.

There are no longer breed restrictions.

## **FIREWORKS INFORMATION**

To make this safe and enjoyable for all, here are a few rules that need to be followed.

1. Hours for the discharge of fireworks in the City shall be only between the hours of **10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>**, and **10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>**, **Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup>**, and **Saturday, July 5<sup>th</sup>**.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge fireworks on City property.
3. Any person discharging fireworks is responsible for all damages resulting from his/her fireworks. They are also responsible for any cleanup of discharged fireworks. The City of Goessel is not responsible for any accidents.
4. Bottle rockets and other similar self-propelled fireworks devices consisting of a tube and attached guiding stick or rod and M80's, shall not be discharged in the City.
5. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, cast or propel fireworks of any kind in the direction of or into the path of any animal, person or group of persons, or from, in the direction of, or into any vehicle of any kind.
6. If the Board of Marion County Commissioners has issued a ban on open burning in an area including the City, there shall be no offer for retail sale, delivery, consignment, gift or other means of furnishing consumer fireworks and there shall be no use of consumer fireworks during the time the ban remains in effect.
7. The Goessel Police and the Fire Chief are authorized to seize and confiscate all fireworks which may be kept, stored or used in violation of Ordinance #235.

## CITY-WIDE STREET-SIDE CLEAN UP GOESSEL RESIDENTS ONLY

SATURDAY—JUNE 28 , 2025—7 AM TO NOON

PUT YOUR ITEMS FOR CLEAN-UP AT THE STREET IN FRONT OF YOUR HOUSE BY 7 A.M. ON SAT., JUNE 28TH & WASTE CONNECTIONS WILL COME & PICK IT UP. SEE BELOW FOR ITEMS THAT ARE PROHIBITED

### **Waste Connections will make one pass thru the city.**

*Waste Connections asks that all items being collected need to be able to be handled by one or two people safely. General trash, small amounts of bundled brush or limbs, Furniture including, chairs, couches, tables. Appliances including, washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwaves small electrical appliances such as TV's, computers, mixers, blenders. Patio grills, patio furniture, push lawn mowers (free of gas & oil) and lawn trimmers. Tree limbs and branches must be cut in 3ft. lengths and bundled for easy pickup. Any trash not in the trash cart must be in throwaway containers such as boxes or bags, no more than 30-gallon capacity. No loose trash or debris or no box or bag may exceed 40 pounds in weight.*

### **Here is a list of items NO LANDFILL OR TRANSFER STATION will accept:**

Car batteries, oil filters, fluorescent light bulbs, propane tanks, any asbestos materials, explosives, paint (we will take empty & dried up paint cans), no hazardous liquids (such as fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, solvents, diesel fuel, gas, oil, transmission fluid, antifreeze, etc...) and tires. REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS AND AIR CONDITIONERS must be tagged by a technician and must have the appropriate paper work with it in order for Waste Connections to pick it up.

THE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE TRAILER WILL BE LOCATED ON THE PARKING LOT SOUTH OF THE CITY BUILDING FROM 8-10. QUESTIONS? PLEASE CALL THE CITY OFFICE AT 367-8111.
