

HOUSE NUMBERS REQUIRED

At the City Council meeting on October 21st, the city council passed Ordinance #312 requiring houses to display numbers identifying the address. The city will begin enforcement after January 1st, 2025. Failure to comply with the ordinance could result in a \$25 fine per day out of compliance with each day constituting a new violation. The city has a limited number of house numbers to give out that will be given on a first come first serve basis. Contact the city clerk for more information or if you have questions.
