Funds raised will benefit school projects and activities for the students.

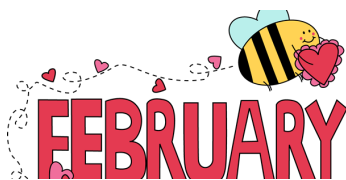
All items purchased will be available for pick up on Tuesday, April 11 from 3:15-5:30 pm in the grade school cafeteria.
