FIREWORKS INFORMATION

To make this safe and enjoyable for all, here are a few rules that need to be followed.

1. Hours for the discharge of fireworks in the City shall be only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to midnight on Friday July 1st, Saturday July 2nd, and Monday July 4th. On Sunday July 3rd and Tuesday July 5th, fireworks may be discharged from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge fireworks on City property.
3. Any person discharging fireworks is responsible for all damages resulting from his/her fireworks. They are also responsible for any cleanup of discharged fireworks. The City of Goessel is not responsible for any accidents.
4. Bottle rockets and other similar self-propelled fireworks devices consisting of a tube and attached guiding stick or rod and M80's, shall not be discharged in the City.
5. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, cast or propel fireworks of any kind in the direction of or into the path of any animal, person or group of persons, or from, in the direction of, or into any vehicle of any kind.
6. If the Board of Marion County Commissioners has issued a ban on open burning in an area including the City, there shall be no offer for retail sale, delivery, consignment, gift or other means of furnishing consumer fireworks and there shall be no use of consumer fireworks during the time the ban remains in effect.
7. The Goessel Police and the Fire Chief are authorized to seize and confiscate all fireworks which may be kept, stored or used in violation of Ordinance #235.

Please respect those around you and let's make this a safe and fun 4th of July Holiday for everyone!!!



Dog Licenses Due

Per Goessel City Code, dog license renewals are due July 1st of each year for all dogs within the city limits. After July 31st, a 50% penalty will be added. Please contact the city office to renew or purchase a new license for your dog(s). There is a **limit of 2 dogs** per residence. If you have been granted permission in the past to have 3 dogs and one of the dogs dies or you get rid of one of the dogs, you cannot replace it with another dog. The **2 dog limit** is going to be strictly enforced. You can drop off your rabies vaccination certificate along with the money for the tags and we will mail the tag out to you. Cost of license: Spayed or Neutered—\$2, Male—\$5, Female—\$10. Reminder: Pit Bulls are not allowed in city limits.



NOTICE: Sump pumps and roof downspouts cannot be discharged into the sewer system. They may be discharged into the public gutter or storm drains or open drainage ditches provided such discharge does not create a nuisance. (Ord. 66, Art. 4, Sec. 8) For a copy of the ordinance come by the City Office. We have had an overwhelming amount of water getting into the sewage system causing our pumps to run and become hot enough to burn up parts that are necessary for the system to work correctly. When the pumps go down this causes sewage to back up and come up into residents basements. Because of this it is recommended by KDHE to have backflow valves installed to prevent the costly repairs of sewage backup.

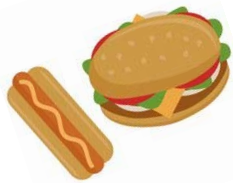

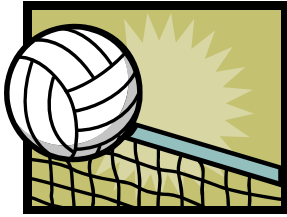
